

A guide on how to access work for students who are off school due to illness

Firstly you will need to locate the school's Curriculum Map which can be found [here](#). Or if you wish to find it directly on our website, click on the curriculum tab that is in our Students section. For the purpose of this guide we will presume you are a Year 8 student looking for a Geography lesson on the topic you would be covering in school.

1. Simply click on your year group in the Curriculum section of our school website.
