Dear Parent/Carer,

At The Bolsover School, we firmly believe that high academic standards are built upon the solid foundation of day-to-day positive habits which include students being smartly dressed and presented in the correct school uniform as per our expectations.

Our full uniform policy can be found on the school website under the 'parents' section or by clicking this link [here](#) but we have recently noticed the standard of uniform for some students is not quite meeting our expectations. We appreciate that at this time of year, students may have outgrown or outworn certain items.

We will fully support all of our families where possible to ensure students are correctly and smartly dressed for school and will regularly allow students to borrow missing items such as a tie or pair of shoes for the day. However, we have recently noticed that some students are returning to borrow the same item for several days and sometimes weeks. On many occasions, these items are lost or not returned meaning our uniform store is very close to empty. Can we remind parents and carers that we would expect them to purchase any replacement or damaged items, relying only on our uniform store in the short term.

We would also like to issue a reminder regarding the following sections of our uniform policy:

- Only black shoes are permitted, not black trainers.
- Black trousers or black knee-length pleated skirt with the school logo (purchased from Logo Leisurewear or Just Schoolwear)
- Blazers should be worn at all times. Staff will allow students to remove their blazer during warm weather.
- Sleeper and stud earrings only – students may wear one discrete nose stud. Nose rings are not permitted.
- False nails are not permitted – students wearing these will be asked to remove them.
- Black socks must be worn – not white

There will be a full uniform check for all students on the first day back after Easter which is **Tuesday 22nd April**. This gives families a 4-week period to replace any missing items of uniform and ensure students are adhering to our uniform policy.

Students not wearing the correct school uniform will be asked to loan the item from the school store; failure to do so will result in a period of isolation.

We thank you for your continued support in ensuring our school and students are 'Nothing but the Best'.
