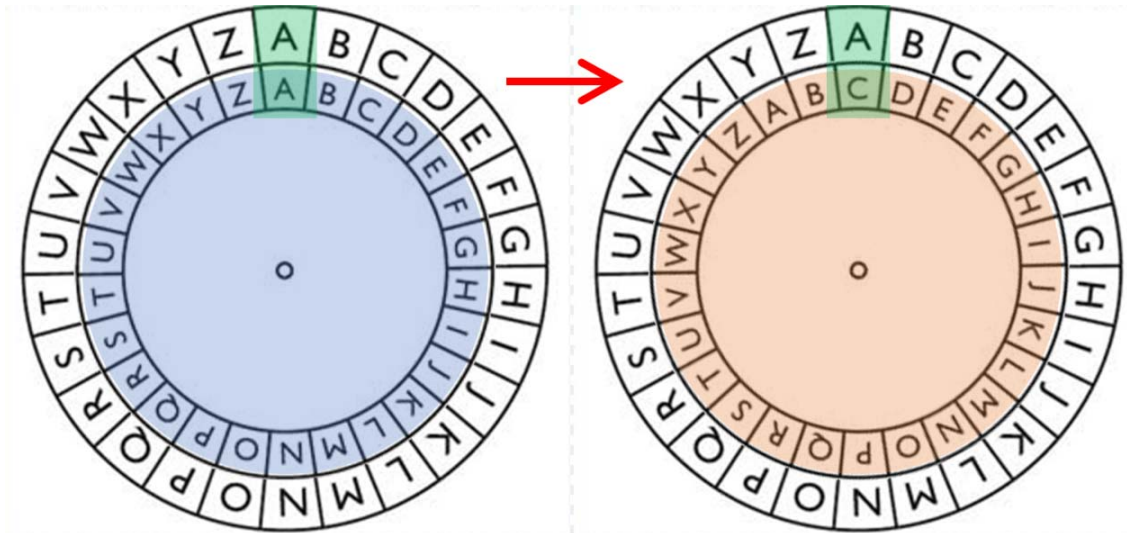


Caesar Wheel

Using the example below, create your own Caesar Wheel.



Creating a Caesar Wheel with movement

Step 1 - You will need to cut out (using paper or card) two blank circles (these will be your wheels) – one should be bigger than the other.

Step 2 – Circle one and two should have the alphabet written around the outside. These are now your Wheels.

Step 3 – Place the two wheels together and attach them through the hole in the centre to create movement.

Step 4 – Give your family member the instruction on how to decode a message you give them. For example – Tell you family member, “I have substituted each letter by the letter that was 5 places further along in the alphabet.”
