Policy: School Uniform Policy

Date: July 2023



It is the policy of The Bolsover School to help students develop a sense of appropriateness of dress. Students will be expected to dress in a manner suitable to a place of study and high standards of personal appearance will be expected.

The current school uniform will be detailed on the school website, with parents/carers being notified in writing of any changes prior to the implementation date.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

- Plain black school trousers or black knee length skirt. Garments with school logo is
 preferred and available from Logo Leisurewear Ltd. However, garments deemed to
 meet the school criteria can be purchased from other named outlets, as detailed
 within the School Uniform Guide. Leggings are not permitted.
- Black shoes (not trainers)
- White shirt with top button fastening
- School house tie (available from Logo Leisurewear Ltd or Just Schoolwear at all times and from the school during term time only)
- Black blazer with school logo (must be purchased from Logo Leisurewear / Just Schoolwear)
- Optional <u>V-neck</u> black <u>woollen</u> jumper to be worn under the blazer (not in place of the blazer). This can be purchase from any outlet or with the school logo from our preferred suppliers if preferred. NB: no hoodies, crew necks, sweatshirts or other logos allowed.
- Only black socks
- A suitable school bag/ruck sack MUST be brought to school every day
- Students are required to bring a pencil case and appropriate equipment to be used in class

UNIFORM REQUIRED FOR PHYSICAL EDUCATION

- Navy blue shorts
- Navy blue long football socks (to be worn when shin pads are required) and navy or white sports socks for general sports activities
- Short sleeved summer/indoor navy-blue polo shirt. The school preference is for this to be purchased from Logo Leisurewear or Just Schoolwear with the school logo, but a plain navy-blue polo-shirt can be purchased from any outlet.
- Training shoes for indoor use no plimsolls
- Optional long-sleeved winter/outdoor ¾ zip sport top with logo is available from Logo Leisurewear or Just Schoolwear or a similar navy or black garment can be purchased from other outlets.
- Plain navy or black sports leggings/track suit bottoms can be worn.
- A long-sleeved navy or black under garment can be worn under the navy-blue polo-shirt when outdoors or during colder months.

UNIFORM REQUIRED FOR EXPRESSIVE ARTS

- Tracksuit bottoms/leggings in navy blue or black
- Plain white T-shirt
- GCSE students do have the chance to purchase an optional GCSE sweatshirt via the school if they wish.

HEADWEAR

- Baseball caps are not permitted to be worn in school or on the school premises
 Sensible headwear may be worn in inclement weather, but must not be worn inside the school building.
- Headwear worn for religious reasons must be plain black.

RULES ABOUT PIERCINGS

For Health & Safety reasons the school will only allow the following piercings to be worn.

- Sleeper and stud earrings are allowed
- No other body piercings are permitted (including tongue studs)
- No facial jewellery is permitted.
- All jewellery MUST be removed prior to PE and other practical lessons

RULES ABOUT MAKE-UP/NAILS AND HAIR

- Make-up is not permitted, other than a light covering of foundation
- Natural nails only, students wearing false nails will be asked to remove them
- Hair colour and style must be appropriate for school. Unnaturally coloured or shaved/patterned hair is not appropriate nor acceptable.
- False eyelashes are not permitted.

Logo Leisurewear or Just Schoolwear can be contacted directly to order both the compulsory blazer and tie, and any optional items detailed. Orders can be placed by telephone or online. A link to the uniform supplier is available on the school website along with an up-to-date price list.

The school provides a uniform guide, which should be referred to, as this details certain garments (trousers/skirts) which can be purchased from alternative outlets other than our preferred suppliers. However, to ensure that garments meet the uniform standards expected at The Bolsover School, only the garments detailed should be purchased. Parents are asked not to purchase garments which are not specified within the booklet as there is a risk that these garments may be deemed to be unacceptable. Items such as shirts, PE shorts, socks etc., can be purchased from outlets of parental choice

Once an order has been placed with Logo Leisurewear or Just Schoolwear, delivery to school can be requested free of charge for collection, or orders can be delivered to a home address (please contact the supplier for current delivery charges). Please note; for orders being collected from school, some form of identification will be required (photographic i.e., driving license/passport) before the order can be released.

Any parents who may be experiencing financial difficulties are able to contact our preferred suppliers directly to arrange payment terms.

Logo Leisurewear and Just Schoolwear aim to dispatch orders within 1 week. However, special size orders may take slightly longer as they may not be held in stock. Sample garments will be held in school for sizing purposes only.

NB:- Please note that The Bolsover School do not benefit financially from any uniform sales via Logo Leisurewear Ltd, Just Schoolwear or any other supplier/outlet.

Used Uniform

The Bolsover School invites parents/students to donate any uniform which is used but in good condition, so that it can be recycled and offered out to other students. Donations can be handed in to our school reception. Parents/carers are asked that donated garments are washed prior to donating, where possible.

Parents/students wishing to access used uniform can do so at Used Uniform Events the school may arrange or by contacting the school to arrange a visit to view the stock on site. The school may make a small charge or ask for a donation for used uniform, to cover the costs of washing (where required), repair and administration, which will go into School Funds towards the cost of student rewards and activities.
