

Log Into Show My Homework


To log in use Show My Homework log in using : <https://www.satchelone.com/login?userType=student>

Ensure that the Student tab is highlighted.

Click “I already have an account”.

Enter your school email address. This is your network user name (the id you use to log on to a pc in school) followed by @bolsover.derbyshire.sch.uk. For example jdoe@bolsover.derbyshire.sch.uk

Then enter your password. Please see the image below.

1. at least one upper case letter
2. at least one lower case letter
3. at least one number &
4. at least one special character (e.g. ! " £ \$ % ^ & *)


Examples of acceptable passwords are Welcome01!, Homework(1)
