



## Home to School Partnership Contract

### The Parent/Carer

I/We will:

- Ensure that my/our child attends school regularly and punctually and does not take unauthorised absences from school including holidays, without prior consultation with the Headteacher.
- Support the school in its expectations of:
  - good behaviour – including the sanctioning of detentions (including after school) if necessary and accepting the stages of the School's adopted behaviour policy
  - a caring approach to individuals within the school
  - respect for the buildings and people who make up the school
  - ensuring that my/our child(ren) always attend school in the correct school uniform as outlined in the School's adopted uniform policy
- Support an effective system of communication by:
  - acknowledging letters
  - informing the school of reasons for absence
  - attending parents' meetings
  - contacting school when the need arises
- Support the school by equipping my/our child(ren) with basic equipment required for learning
- Supporting the school by ensuring uniform is worn correctly, including rules relating to make-up and jewellery
- Ensure the removal of all facial piercings and retainers prior to entering the school site
- Ensure the removal of ear piercings before any physical activity
- Ensure that my/our child(ren) will be able to attend school with adequate nutrition
- Provide a moral and social standard, which encourages each member of the school community to be caring and polite towards each other
- Communicate with the school in an appropriate manner, refraining from threats, aggressive behaviour and unacceptable language (swearing)
- Ensure that I/we provide and update contact details if any changes are made.
- Support the school to ensure that my/our child(ren) attend, fully engage and participate in all Remote Learning Lessons/tasks provided by the school

### The Student

I will:

- Attend school and all lessons punctually
- Attend, fully engage and participate in all Remote Learning Lessons/tasks provided by the school
- Be prepared for school by:-
  - Always wearing the correct uniform



- bringing the equipment needed for learning including a school bag and essential stationery items
- ensuring that I am physically able to participate in the school day
- Do all school and homework set to the best of my ability and on time
- Adhere to the school's behaviour policy and the range of rewards and sanctions associated with it
- Treat everyone and everything in school with respect
- Communicate with staff, students and visitors in an appropriate manner, refraining from threats, aggressive behaviour and unacceptable language (swearing)
